## EXPLOSIVES REGULATIONS 2014

### RECIPIENT COMPETENT AUTHORITY (TRANSFER) DOCUMENT

For transfers of explosives within Great Britain, this document serves as a Recipient Competent Authority (Transfer) Document ("RCA document") granted and issued under Regulation 8, and within the meaning of regulation 8(9), of the Explosives Regulations 2014. Accordingly, this RCA document, which is a separate document to the certificate above, gives the approval of the competent authority, which is the Health and Safety Executive, to the transfer of the explosives referred to in paragraph 3 of the certificate above and also the following additional explosives:

(\*) *Primers, Cap Type Only*

Cartridges, which are empty but with a primer, which are assigned UN 0055 or UN 0378 and which are intended for use in small arms within the meaning given in regulation 2(1) of the Explosives Regulations 2014.

Cartridges power device, UN 0275, 0276, 0323 or 0381, designed to produce mechanical actions such as inflation, linear or rotary motion, projection of fastening devices or extinguishing agents; and consisting of a casing with a charge of deflagrating explosive and a means of ignition.

Smokeless powder, UN 0161 or 0509, when to be transferred by a person who either is registered as a firearms dealer under section 33 of the Firearms Act 1968 or holds-

- (i) a permit granted under section 7 of that Act;
- (ii) a firearms certificate granted under section 27 of that Act;
- (iii) a shotgun certificate granted under section 28 of that Act; or
- (iv) a permit granted under section 17 of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988.

For the purposes of granting and issuing this approval, the Chief Officer of Police referred to in paragraph 1 of the certificate acts on behalf of the Health and Safety Executive under an agency agreement. The person signing the certificate on behalf of the Chief Officer of Police does so also for the purposes of this RCA document. This approval is valid for the period referred to in paragraph 2 of the certificate or until notice of revocation of the approval covered by this RCA document is served on the document holder by the Health and Safety Executive, whichever is the sooner.
